| | The briefest liaison with grape skins tantalisingly leaves this delicate colour yet exudes a floral fragrance evolving soft red berry richness. | |
| 4 | Pol Roger, Réserve, Brut, France NV | £72.00 |
| | Notes of white flowers, citrus and stone fruit with delicate honey and brioche characters in the background. Fresh and vibrant, it is beautifully balanced with fine acidity, and offers a long, attractive crystalline finish. Very classy indeed. | |

| | This wine is only partially fermented, until some grape spirit is added to halt the fermentation and leave a lot of natural sugars unfermented in wine. The results are a terrifically more-ish unctuous wine. | |

| | Delicate & refreshing, flora & perfectly balanced with hints of citrus and exotic fruits. | |
| 18 | La Campagne Viognier 2019, Pays d'Oc, France | £25.00 |
| | Dry with all the classic characteristics of the Viognier grape, exhibiting peaches, dried apricots and floral aromas. | |
| 19 | Sancerre 2018, Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot, France | £45.00 |
| | Stylish and crisp aromas of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean finish, from one of the finest and most dynamic producers. | |
| 26 | Chablis Domaine Vincent Dampit 2018, France | £42.50 |
| | Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis. | |
| 82 | Meursault Clos Du Cromin 2015, Olivier Leflaive Freres Cote D'or, Burgundy | £75.00 |
| | Deep green-gold. Vanilla & burnt cream on the nose. Notes of herbs & tropical fruits on the palate contrasting with firm acidity a fine backbone, going to a rich, lemon-oak finish. | |
| 83 | Macon Verze 2016, Domain Leflaive, Burgundy | £49.50 |
| | A rich wine with a green, gold colour, a clean, subtly creamy, zesty nose and a palate that has a lovely density and almost waxy richness lifted by a beautiful freshness and acidity. | |
| 84 | Puligny-Montrachet 2017, François Carillon | £65.00 |
| | Pale, shimmering gold, this presents a very attractive blend of citrus, white flowers, crushed shell minerals and warm pastry. The palate, similarly, balances purity and focus with underlying richness, maintaining tension and a sense of direction throughout. | |
| 85 | Côtes-Du-Rhône 2017, Blanc Les Becs Fins, Tardieu, Laurent | £39.00 |
| | This is a fine introduction to modern Rhône whites. The nose & palate equally present stone fruit & peaches & cream allied to floral notes & a fresh, brisk acidity. Here its more gregarious elements are reined in somewhat by the power of the location so that it adds a much more subtly aromatic character to the finished wine. Mineral elements also complement the perfumed fruit. | |



ITALIAN WHITES

- 15 **Grave del Friuli Pinot Grigio 2019, Bergo Tesis, Fantinel, Italy** £27.50

Apples, peach and pear notes are all present in this refreshing flavoursome Pinot Grigio.

- 29 **Gavi di Gavi 2019, Antonio e Raimondo** £32.50

This famous Piedmontese wine is produced from the Cortese grape. Floral rose petal notes and a touch of sweet spice aromas abound, whilst the palate has a good weight of ripe pear fruit and a delicate, mineral finish.

SPANISH WHITES

- 16 **Don Jacobo Rioja Viura 2019, Bodegas Corral** £26.50

Fresh, dry, crisp and modern, from this classic Spanish region using the local Viura grape.

- 28 **Albarino 2018, Pazo la Maza, Adegas Galegas, Rias Baixas, Spain** £37.00

Refreshing yet intense. Mid-palate has a nice chewy texture to it and the finish is crisp and refreshing.

AUSTRALIAN WHITES

- 30 **Block 1A Chardonnay 2018, The Lane, Adelaide Hills** £39.50

From high up in the Adelaide Hills, with its cooler climate, the multi award winning estate The Lane produces a Chardonnay with a distinct nod towards the wines of Burgundy. Fruit ripened by the Australian sun is full, yet the wine has a lovely line of acidity giving it an elegance and a finesse.

NEW ZEALAND WHITES

- 20 **Sauvignon Blanc 2019, Lofthouse Estate, Marlborough, New Zealand** £27.50

Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc at its best - grassy, fresh and invigorating, rather too easy to drink.

- 22 **Riesling 2018, Vidal, Marlborough, New Zealand** £31.00

Great "New World" Riesling with lime and floral aromas and citrus fruit flavours, medium dry.



SOUTH AFRICAN WHITES

- 23 **Nederburg The Manor Sauvignon Blanc 2019, Western Cape, South Africa** £23.00
Zesty wine with grassy, asparagus and tropical fruit flavours with a deliciously refreshing finish
- 27 **Nederburg The Manor Chardonnay 2018, Western Cape, South Africa** £23.00
Aromas of lime with vanilla spice: crisp and fresh with a creamy texture and subtle citrus and melon flavours.
- 96 **Sauvignon Blanc 2019, Nelson Estate, Paarl, South Africa** £35.00
The 2019 Sauvignon Blanc shows zingy, bright, tropical fruits that abound from the nose and palate. A melange of guava, pineapple and lemon curd lead to a medium bodied but intensely Flavoured, textured palate. Hints of wet earth and bell pepper give complexity and depth, albeit in a soft and comforting manor. The linear finish shows a mineral, gravelly edge that balances the pure-fruited stance.

ROSE WINES

- 10 **Coteaux Varois en Provence Rosé 2019, Reflet, Estandon, France** £26.50
Vibrant aromas of peach and strawberry: dry with citrus fruit on the refreshing finish.
- 11 **La Brouette Rose 2019, France** £23.00
A deliciously light Provencal style Rose, with fresh, juicy ripe red berry vibrant fruit, gently spiced and a zesty acidity.
- 12 **Whispering Hills White Zinfandel 2019, California, USA** £27.50
Loads of fresh summer-fruit flavours and lively acidity. Medium-bodied to appeal to most palates, California's own Zinfandel.

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| 35 | Beaujolais-Villages Combe aux Jacques 2017, Louis Jadot, France | £32.50 |
| | Louis Jadot have increased to 40% the amount of wine they source from 'cru' villages such as Regnié, to produce a fuller style. | |
| 38 | Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir 2018, Vin de France, France | £27.50 |
| | From the foothills of the Pyrenees, soft, lightly oaked cherries and blueberries with a hint of spice. | |
| 39 | Château Lyonnat 2012, Lussac-Saint-Émilion, France | £39.50 |
| | Deep garnet with a warm spiced bread and red fruit character; powerful, yet supple; with vanilla aromas on the finish | |
| 40 | Cotes De Nuits Villages 2014, Domaine Gilles Jourdan, France | £50.00 |
| | Aromas of dark, complex and series black, brooding fruit, mixed with sweetly fruited fresh berries. Pepper spiced earthly Pinot fruit that is balanced and deliciously elegant. | |
| 47 | Côtes du Rhône 2017, Les Abeilles Rouge, Jean-Luc Colombo France | £32.50 |
| | Fresh and silky on the palate, the aromas follow through on to the mouth prolonged by notes of liquorice and spice. Spends nine months maturing in oak. | |
| 48 | Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2017, Les Clés de la Tour, Ogier, France | £48.50 |
| | Bright, solid, powerful fruit, overlaid with warm spice and savoury notes. | |
| 89 | Gevry-Chambertin Clos des Varoilles 1er Cru Monopole, Domain des Varoilles 2014 | £85.00 |
| | Textbook Pinot Noir from a highly lauded vintage - consummate balance between elegance and power. Even in good vintage there can be temptations to go just a little too far in pursuit of something more impressive, leading to an imbalance in the finished wine. Gilbert Hammel tirelessly pursues elegance, aromatics and balance in his wine and this old vine premier cru vineyard monopole is a fine the ambassador for Gevrey-Chambertin and for the vintage. | |
| 90 | L'Hospitalet Gazin 2013, Pomerol | £61.00 |
| | The second wine of Château Gazin, this is one of the very greatest values in Pomerol. It has produced a terrific wine in 2012. Plummy and sweet with excellent concentration, density and a delectable, flowery and fresh power to the finish. | |



- 91 **Domaine L'Aurage 2013, Cotes de Castillon** £52.00
- This magnificent property, adjacent to St Emilion was discovered by the Mitjavile family, owners of the great St Emilion, Chateau Tertre Roteboeuf and it is cut from the same very exacting cloth. 80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, the wine is silky-textured, oozing richly extracted black & red fruits and spice with beautifully rounded tannins. Very accomplished and polished.
- 92 **Chateau Ponet Canet 2011, 5eme Cru Pauillac** £140.00
- This stellar estate continues woo the critics with their magnificent wines. The 2011 comes bounding out of the glass with exuberant notes of redcurrant jelly, warm Cassis and blackberries, plus a touch of dried mint, mocha, smoked meats and yeast extract with a waft of pencil lead. Medium to full bodied, the palate has bags of energy with lively red and black fruits and a compelling mineral note, finishing upliftingly long.
- 94 **Chateau La Grave a Pomerol 2013, Pomerol** £85.00
- From JP Moueix collections of unparalleled top quality Pomerols, which includes the great Chateau Petrus itself! The La Grave a Pomerol comes from the sandier soils and produces a more elegant mid weight style, exhibiting notes of cherries, black fruits, balsam wood and underbrush against the backdrop of a mineral structure and a touch of tobacco. There is a definite sense of classicism in this beautifully lush Pomerol.
- 95 **Château Langoa Barton, 2eme Cru Classé, St. Julien 2011** £95.00
- The very impressive Chateau Langoa Barton sits just to the west of the main road that traverses the Medoc & has been home to Anthony Barton's family since the 1820's. Langoa Barton is one of the bargains of the Medoc & this vintage is no different. Super ripe blackberry, Bilberry & plum on the nose with everything in synch. The palate is ripe, decadent & concentrated with bold extrovert tannins & a rich grippy finish with notes of cedar & graphite. An impressive wine!
- 105 **Château Bélair Monage 2011, 1er Grand Cru Classé St Émilion, Bordeaux** £150.00
- This tiny jewel of an estate, situated next to Château Ausone and under the expert tutelage of the Moueix family, produces only about 1500 cases per year. Gorgeous aromas of kirsch, crushed rock, raspberry and subtle oak followed by a medium bodied concentrated mouthfeel.

SOUTH AFRICA REDS

- 45 **Nederburg The Manor Cabernet Sauvignon 2019, Western Cape** £23.00
- Shows an abundance of ripe berry and dark chocolate aromas with nuances of oak in the background; ripe fruit and delicate oak spice Flavours, firm tannins and a lingering finish.



- 52 **Nederburg The Manor Shiraz 2018, Western Cape** £23.00
An abundance of prunes and oak-spice aromas met on the palate by Flavours of ripe plums and cherries.
- 97 **The Major Series Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Ernie Els Estate, Stellenbosch** £57.00
The 2017 is a lovely vintage showing the red fruit spectrum of Cabernet Sauvignon. The nose tempts with notes of coconut, vanilla, raspberries and sweet spice. This leads to a polished, supple palate opening to hints of fine white chocolate. The richness of cranberries and morello cherry gives length while the salty liquorice edge offers freshness and elegance. Crunchy, red-fruited tannins melt into a soft, slightly creamy finish.
- 98 **The Major Series Merlot 2017, Ernie Els Estate, Stellenbosch** £57.00
The 2017 vintage Major Series Merlot has all the hallmarks of a classic Merlot, with ripe plums and earthy notes, supported by a core of minerality. The wine is fleshed out with ripe strawberry, forest underfloor and a hint of dark chocolate. This is a really lovely wine with a ripe juicy concentrated heart and a long finish.
- 99 **Proprietor's Blend 2016, Ernie Els Estate, Stellenbosch** £67.00
The 2016 Proprietors Blend (60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Shiraz, 5% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, 5% Malbec, and 5% Petit Verdot) is a towering Bordeaux style with a dash of Shiraz. It has a pitch-black core with a deeply rich hue, leading to a nose that dazzles with vanilla, blackberry, liquorice and cherry. Whiffs of wildflowers and a touch of cedar spice add refined depth and complexity, all coated by incredibly fine, chalky tannins. Slightly backward and brooding in its youth, there is an aristocratic feel to its long, silky and powerful finish

NEW ZEALAND REDS

- 44 **Vidal Reserve Pinot Noir 2018, Marlborough** £45.00
Raspberry sweetness showing through a youthful character, yet more structure and complexity developing from barrique-ageing.

AUSTRALIAN REDS

- 49 **The Southerly Shiraz 2018, South-East Australia** £29.50
Deep garnet with purple hues the nose has vibrant red and black berries, with violets and sweet spice. The palate is silky with juicy black plums, sweet blueberry and a touch of mocha.
- 50 **Little Tacker Grenache Shiraz Mourvedre 2017, Barossa Boy, Barossa Valley** £47.50
Aromas of fresh raspberries, lavender and milk chocolate. The palate is generous and textured with ripe fruits of the forest, earthy notes and dark chocolate, toasty vanilla and a savoury finish.



SPANISH REDS

- 55 **Belezos Rioja Crianza 2017, Corney & Barrow** £37.00
- Classic Rioja from small family winery. The palate displays rich plum, dark cherry fruit and warm spices, long lasting on the palate.
- 88 **Psi 2017, Peter Sisseck, Bodegas y Vinedos Alnardo, Ribera Del Duero** £49.50
- This is an inviting, shimmering, plum-purple in colour, with a firm, bright rim. The nose offers an explosion of ripe, aromatic, black fruit, plum and black cherry compote, complemented by mineral notes. The palate is expansive, generous with abundant fruit, richly textured and bursting with personality. Honest and accessible, this is energetic and lithe, driven and focused throughout, with a freshness and purity borne of natural acidity - harmonious and long on the finish - another winning Psi.

ITALIAN REDS

- 37 **Cabernet Franc 2018, La Tunella, Collio Orientali di Friuli** £37.50
- A cracking wine from this great Bordeaux grape variety in north east Italy. Bags of juicy and concentrated cassis.
- 51 **Passori Rosso 2019, Veneto, Italy** £29.50
- A rich, smooth red wine, showing plum and dried fruit notes.
- 86 **Le Cupole di Trinoro 2015, Andrea Franchetti, Tenuta di Trinoro** £49.50
- A stunning baby Super Tuscan, by one of Italy's greatest producers, Andrea Franchetti. Rich ruby-garnet in colour, the wine reveals exuberant red and black fruit from the outset, characterful and inviting, sweetness enhanced by a heady dash of spice, punctuated by minerals and underpinned by fine-grained tannins - great value.
- 54 **Chianti Classico Terre di Prenzano 2017, Vignamaggio, Tuscany** £39.50
- The Vignamaggio family estate makes traditional, Tuscan wines at the very top level. The grapes for their 'Terre di Prenzano' are grown in the very best part of the higher quality Classico area. With dried herbs, spice and moreish sour cherry flavours, this wine is concentrated, yet restrained.



CHILEAN REDS

41 **Luis Felipe Edwards Gran Reserva Merlot 2018, Colchagua Valley** £27.50

Big and bold, aged for about a year in a mixture of new and second-use French oak barrels, it is absolutely packed to bursting point with dark plum, cassis, bramble fruits, blueberry and winter spice.

53 **Veramonte Carmenère 2018, Colchagua Valley** £29.00

Notes of raspberry and cherry on the nose, ripe blue and black fruits being added on the medium bodied palate: a touch of spice on the finish.

ARGENTINIAN REDS

46 **Chamuyo Malbec 2018, Mendoza** £29.00

Their Chamuyo Malbec is a juicy, supple wine with ripe summer fruits, herbs and warm spice.

87 **Malbec 2017, Bodega Ruca Malen, Mendoza** £42.00

A premium example of Argentina's signature Malbec grape, from boutique winery in Argentina's most classic wine producing region. The Upper Mendoza Valley has gained worldwide fame for its stunning, full-bodied reds. This Malbec vines grow at high altitudes, thus helping to combine power with elegance. With vibrant, cherry-plum notes and a spicy, liquorice finish, this wine is moreish and delicious
