| | A rich wine with a green, gold colour, a clean, subtly creamy, zesty nose and a palate that has a lovely density and almost waxy richness lifted by a beautiful freshness and acidity. | |
| 84 | Puligny-Montrachet 2019, François Carillon | £95.00 |
| | Pale, shimmering gold, this presents a very attractive blend of citrus, white flowers, crushed shell minerals and warm pastry. The palate, similarly, balances purity and focus with underlying richness, maintaining tension and a sense of direction throughout. | |
| 85 | Côtes-Du-Rhône 2019, Blanc Les Becs Fins, Tardieu, Laurent | £39.00 |
| | This is a fine introduction to modern Rhône whites. The nose & palate equally present stone fruit & peaches & cream allied to floral notes & a fresh, brisk acidity. Here its more gregarious elements are reined in somewhat by the power of the location so that it adds a much more subtly aromatic character to the finished wine. Mineral elements also complement the perfumed fruit. | |

- 29 **Gavi di Gavi 2021, Antonio e Raimondo** £32.50
- This famous Piedmontese wine is produced from the Cortese grape. Floral rose petal notes and a touch of sweet spice aromas abound, whilst the palate has a good weight of ripe pear fruit and a delicate, mineral finish.

SPANISH WHITES

- 16 **Viña Garedo Viura Sauvignon Blanc 2021, DO Rueda** £28.00
- A mouth-watering white, bursting with herbaceous, grassy notes and hints of lemon sherbet. Easy drinking and characterful, this wine is ideal by itself or with lighter fish and seafood dishes.
- 28 **Albarino 2020, Pazo la Maza, Adegas Galegas, Rias Baixas, Spain** £37.00
- Refreshing yet intense. Mid-palate has a nice chewy texture to it and the finish is crisp and refreshing.

AUSTRALIAN WHITES

- 30 **Block 1A Chardonnay 2019, The Lane, Adelaide Hills** £39.50
- From high up in the Adelaide Hills, with its cooler climate, the multi award winning estate The Lane produces a Chardonnay with a distinct nod towards the wines of Burgundy. Fruit ripened by the Australian sun is full, yet the wine has a lovely line of acidity giving it an elegance and a finesse.

NEW ZEALAND WHITES

- 20 **Ana Sauvignon Blanc 2021, Eradus Estate, Awatere Valley, Marlborough** £29.50
- Pale lemon in colour. The nose is typically Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, with plenty of upfront grass and gooseberries. The palate is fresh and clean with characters similar to the nose. There is a lovely citric acidity to balance.
- 22 **Homer Riesling 2020, Marlborough,** £35.00
- Inviting and effortless, the nose evokes notes of kaffir lime leaf, green apple and honeysuckle. Mouth-watering acidity and a soft finish give Homer great balance, intensified with food.

SOUTH AFRICAN WHITES



- 96 **Sauvignon Blanc 2021, Nelson Estate, Paarl, South Africa** £35.00

The 2019 Sauvignon Blanc shows zingy, bright, tropical fruits that abound from the nose and palate. A melange of guava, pineapple and lemon curd lead to a medium bodied but intensely Flavoured, textured palate. Hints of wet earth and bell pepper give complexity and depth, albeit in a soft and comforting manor. The linear finish shows a mineral, gravelly edge that balances the pure-fruited stance.

CHILEAN WHITES

- 27 **Unoaked Chardonnay 2021, El Campesino, Chile** £23.00

Pale gold in colour with green tints, this un-oaked chardonnay is ripe, round and pure with notes of delicate stone fruit and fresh melon.

ROSÉ WINES

- 10 **Source Gabriel 2020, Château de L'Eveque, Côtes de Provence** £35.00

Source Gabriel offers fresh red berries, custard and citrus fragrances on the nose as well as a dense, creamy mouthfeel, and a refreshing, zesty finish. Perfect to drink on its own or to accompany many dishes from Asian food to grilled fish and seafood.

- 11 **La Brouette Rosé 2021, France** £23.00

A deliciously light Provencal style Rose, with fresh, juicy ripe red berry vibrant fruit, gently spiced and a zesty acidity.

FRENCH REDS

- 35 **Beaujolais-Villages La Cave de la Croisee 2020, Ferraud** £37.00

Deep purple/red in colour. The nose is pure fresh cherry with some floral notes. The palate is juicy and lively with bright crunch red-fruit flavours and some blueberry character. This wine has great structure and texture.

- 38 **Pinot Noir 2020, La Muse de Cabestany, Pays D'Oc** £29.50

La Muse de Cabestany Pinot Noir offers very perfumed violets and juicy ripe cherries on the nose. Silky and smooth on the palate, this elegant wine displays hints of rose petal and liquorice and a fresh, lingering finish.

- 39 **Château La Courolle 2019, St Emilion** £42.50

Lustrous, deep plum, this has a very inviting nose, ideal for early drinking Right Blank claret, rich in ripe cherry and cassis, with floral notes and earthy mineral undertones. The palate reveals power and body, all-the-while retaining aromatic complexity.

- 94 **Chateau La Grave a Pomerol 2015, Pomerol** £85.00
 From JP Moueix collections of unparalleled top quality Pomerols, which includes the great Chateau Petrus itself! The La Grave a Pomerol comes from the sandier soils and produces a more elegant mid weight style, exhibiting notes of cherries, black fruits, balsam wood and underbrush against the backdrop of a mineral structure and a touch of tobacco. There is a definite sense of classicism in this beautifully lush Pomerol.
- 95 **Château Leoville Barton 2012, 2eme Cru St Julien, Bordeaux** £125.00
 The 2012 Leoville-Barton is laced with dark red and blue-fleshed stone fruits, spices, sweet spice, mint and liquorice. This is decidedly robust, mineral and forward Leoville-Barton, beautifully fashioned and elegant that will drink well relatively early.
- 105 **Château Bélair Monage 2011, 1er Grand Cru Classé St Émilion, Bordeaux** £150.00
 This tiny jewel of an estate, situated next to Château Ausone and under the expert tutelage of the Moueix family, produces only about 1500 cases per year. Gorgeous aromas of kirsch, crushed rock, raspberry and subtle oak followed by a medium bodied concentrated mouthfeel.

SOUTH AFRICA REDS

- 41 **Bainskloof Merlot 2021, Breede River** £33.00
 Deep ruby red in colour with rich mocha and sweet black fruit on the nose. The palate is reflective of the nose with additional ripe red fruit and leafy notes.
- 97 **The Major Series Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Ernie Els Estate, Stellenbosch** £57.00
 The 2017 is a lovely vintage showing the red fruit spectrum of Cabernet Sauvignon. The nose tempts with notes of coconut, vanilla, raspberries and sweet spice. This leads to a polished, supple palate opening to hints of fine white chocolate. The richness of cranberries and morello cherry gives length while the salty liquorice edge offers freshness and elegance. Crunchy, red-fruited tannins melt into a soft, slightly creamy finish.
- 98 **The Major Series Merlot 2017, Ernie Els Estate, Stellenbosch** £57.00
 The 2017 vintage Major Series Merlot has all the hallmarks of a classic Merlot, with ripe plums and earthy notes, supported by a core of minerality. The wine is fleshed out with ripe strawberry, forest underfloor and a hint of dark chocolate. This is a really lovely wine with a ripe juicy concentrated heart and a long finish.
- 99 **Proprietor's Blend 2017, Ernie Els Estate, Stellenbosch** £67.00



The 2016 Proprietors Blend (60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Shiraz, 5% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, 5% Malbec, and 5% Petit Verdot) is a towering Bordeaux style with a dash of Shiraz. It has a pitch-black core with a deeply rich hue, leading to a nose that dazzles with vanilla, blackberry, liquorice and cherry. Whiffs of wildflowers and a touch of cedar spice add refined depth and complexity, all coated by incredibly fine, chalky tannins. Slightly backward and brooding in its youth, there is an aristocratic feel to its long, silky and powerful finish

NEW ZEALAND REDS

44 **Pinot Noir 2021, Eradus Estate, Awatare Valley, Marlborough** £47.50

Deep, dark ruby, with purple flashes. The nose has meaty, dark fruit and some farmyard notes. The palate has plenty of dark berry fruit and some savoury and earthy characters. This is all balanced with the trademark Eradus acidity, delicacy and freshness

AUSTRALIAN REDS

49 **The Southerly Shiraz 2018, South-East Australia** £29.50

Deep garnet with purple hues the nose has vibrant red and black berries, with violets and sweet spice. The palate is silky with juicy black plums, sweet blueberry and a touch of mocha.

50 **Little Tacker Grenache Shiraz Mourvedre 2018, Barossa Boy, Barossa Valley** £47.50

Aromas of fresh raspberries, lavender and milk chocolate. The palate is generous and textured with ripe fruits of the forest, earthy notes and dark chocolate, toasty vanilla and a savoury finish.

SPANISH REDS

55 **Belezos Rioja Crianza 2019, Bodegas Zugober** £37.00

Classic Rioja from small family winery. The palate displays rich plum, dark cherry fruit and warm spices, long lasting on the palate.

88 **Psi 2018, Peter Sisseck, Bodegas y Vinedos Alnardo, Ribera Del Duero** £49.50

This is an inviting, shimmering, plum-purple in colour, with a firm, bright rim. The nose offers an explosion of ripe, aromatic, black fruit, plum and black cherry compote, complemented by mineral notes. The palate is expansive, generous with abundant fruit, richly textured and bursting with personality. Honest and accessible, this is energetic and lithe, driven and focused throughout, with a freshness and purity borne of natural acidity - harmonious and long on the finish - another winning Psi.

ITALIAN REDS



- 37 **Cabernet Franc 2019, La Tunella, Collio Orientali di Friuli** £37.50
A cracking wine from this great Bordeaux grape variety in north east Italy. Bags of juicy and concentrated cassis.
- 51 **Soraie 2019, Cecilia Beretta, Veneto** £29.50
Deep ruby red, with intense aromas of red berries and sweet spice. Rich, velvety and round on the palate, with flavours of black plums, cherry, vanilla and a moreish chocolatey finish.
- 86 **Le Cupole di Trinoro 2016, Andrea Franchetti, Tenuta di Trinoro** £53.00
A stunning baby Super Tuscan, by one of Italy's greatest producers, Andrea Franchetti. Rich ruby-garnet in colour, the wine reveals exuberant red and black fruit from the outset, characterful and inviting, sweetness enhanced by a heady dash of spice, punctuated by minerals and underpinned by fine-grained tannins – great value.
- 54 **Chianti Classico Terre di Prenzano 2018, Vignamaggio, Tuscany** £39.50
The Vignamaggio family estate makes traditional, Tuscan wines at the very top level. The grapes for their 'Terre di Prenzano' are grown in the very best part of the higher quality Classico area. With dried herbs, spice and moreish sour cherry flavours, this wine is concentrated, yet restrained.

CHILEAN REDS

- 52 **Puertas Antiguas Shiraz 2021, Valle Central, Chile** £23.00
This is a deliciously inviting wine – ripe, soft-textured and rich Shiraz, which bursts with black fruits, violet notes and a hint of peppery spice.
- 53 **Casa Felipe Carmenère 2021, Valle Central** £28.00
Aromas of cherries and plums and subtle notes of mocha, chocolate and spices. Pleasing weight in the mouth, with sweet tannins and a velvety finish.

ARGENTINIAN REDS



- 46 **Chamuyo Malbec 2019, Mendoza** £29.00
- This Malbec is bright cherry red with a violet hue. It shows intense aromas of ripe, red summer fruit, herbs and subtle warm spice. The palate is medium-bodied, rounded yet fresh with soft, supple tannins.
- 87 **Malbec 2019, Bodega Ruca Malen, Mendoza** £42.00
- A premium example of Argentina's signature Malbec grape, from boutique winery in Argentina's most classic wine producing region. The Upper Mendoza Valley has gained worldwide fame for its stunning, full-bodied reds. This Malbec vines grow at high altitudes, thus helping to combine power with elegance. With vibrant, cherry-plum notes and a spicy, liquorice finish, this wine is moreish and delicious.
