| 85 | CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE, BLANC LES BECS FINS, TARDIEU-LAURENT, 2022 | £41 |
| | This is a fine introduction to modern Rhône whites. The nose & palate equally present stone fruit & peaches & cream allied to floral notes & a fresh, brisk acidity. Here its more gregarious elements are reined in somewhat by the power of the location so that it adds a much more subtly aromatic character to the finished wine. Mineral elements also complement the perfumed fruit. | |

| | La Muse de Cabestany Pinot Noir offers very perfumed violets and juicy ripe cherries on the nose. Silky and smooth on the palate, this elegant wine displays hints of rose petal and liquorice and a fresh, lingering finish. | |
| 39 | CHATEAU LA COUROLLE, ST EMILION, 2020 | £47 |
| | Lustrous, deep plum, this has a very inviting nose, ideal for early drinking Right Bank claret, rich in ripe cherry and cassis, with floral notes and earthy mineral undertones. The palate reveals power and body, all - the - while retaining aromatic complexity. | |
| 40 | COTES DE NUITS VILLAGES, DOMAINE GILLES JOURDAN, 2018 | £57 |
| | Aromas of dark, complex and serious black, brooding fruit, mixed with sweetly fruited fresh berries. Pepper spiced earthy Pinot fruit that is balanced and deliciously elegant. | |
| 45 | DOMAINE DE SAISSAC, PAYS D'OC, 2021 | £31 |
| | Small wine estate on the banks of the historic Canal du Midi. A well balanced wine; fine and juicy with delicate, cedar spice notes. <i>Also available by the glass</i> | |
| 47 | CÔTES DU RHÔNE, DOMAINE GONNET, 2019 | £36 |
| | Violet, chocolate and dried herb notes on the nose., More of the same on the palate, perfectly balanced with spicy liquorice, dark fruit and a fresh acidity. | |
| 48 | CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE GRAND RESERVE, CHATEAUX BEAUCHENE, 2021 | £57 |
| | Rich, dark and handsome! This full - bodied and concentrated red exudes moreish flavours of baked plum and damson fruit, kirsch and sweet spice. Long and sustained on the palate, yet very well balanced – great with bolder red meats. | |

The second wine of Château Gazin, this is one of the very greatest values in Pomerol. Plummy and sweet with excellent concentration, density and a delectable, flowery and fresh power to the finish. | £67 |
| 91 | DOMAINE L'AURAGE, COTES DE CASTILLON, 2017
This magnificent property, adjacent to St Emilion was discovered by the Mitjavile family, owners of the great St Emilion, Chateau Tertre Roteboeuf and it is cut from the same very exacting cloth. 80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, the wine is silky - textured, oozing richly extracted black & red fruits and spice with beautifully rounded tannins. Very accomplished and polished. | £62 |
| 92 | PULIGNY MONTRACHET, DOMAINE FRANCOIS CARILLON, 2020
Francois is the 16th generation of his family, dating back to the 16th century to work the soil of Puligny Montrachet. Aromas of white flowers, bright pears and peaches, this wine just hits that sweet spot between its insinuatingly pristine fruit, precise acidity and a certain textural richness, which is just so wonderful. Absolute class from a master of his art! | £150 |
| 94 | CHATEAU LA GRAVE A POMEROL, POMEROL, 2016
From JP Moueix collections of unparalleled top quality Pomerols, which includes the great Chateau Petrus itself! The La Grave a Pomerol comes from the sandier soils and produces a more elegant mid weight style, exhibiting notes of cherries, black fruits, balsam wood and underbrush against the backdrop of a mineral structure and a touch of tobacco. There is a definite sense of classicism in this beautifully lush Pomerol. | £87 |
| 95 | CHATEAU PHELAN SEGUR 2008, ST ESTEPHE
The 2008 is an excellent wine from this famous Saint Estephe estate. It has a clean, well - defined bouquet with blackberry, earth, black olive and crushed stone. This has great precision and clarity. The palate is medium - bodied with well - integrated oak, very smooth in texture, caressing the mouth, with good weight on the finish. It has a very attractive mouthfeel and impressive length. | £120 |
| 105 | CHATEAU RAUZAN SEGLA, ZEME CRU MARGAUX 2006
One of the Greatest Bordeaux wines, where finesse, elegance and unparalleled delicacy Create a full and round mouthfeel. The Intense deep ruby red colour with purple hues seeping Through, Is accompanied by the sweet aromas of bay leaf, black currants, truffles and spicy liquorice. 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| 37 | CABERNET FRANC, LA TUNELLA, COLLIO ORIENTALI DI FRUILI, 2020
A cracking wine from this great Bordeaux grape variety in north east Italy. Bags of juicy and concentrated cassis. | £41 |
| 51 | SORAIE, CECILIA BERETTA, VENETO, 2021
Deep ruby red, with intense aromas of red berries and sweet spice. Rich, velvety and round on the palate, with flavours of black plums, cherry, vanilla and a moreish chocolatey finish. | £37 |
| 86 | LE CUPOLE DI TRINORO, ANDREA FRANCHETTI, TENUTA DI TRINORO, 2016
A stunning baby Super Tuscan, by one of Italy's greatest producers, Andrea Franchetti. Rich ruby-garnet in colour, the wine reveals exuberant red and black fruit from the outset, characterful and inviting, sweetness enhanced by a heady dash of spice, punctuated by minerals and underpinned by fine-grained tannins – great value. | £60 |
| 54 | CHIANTI CLASSICO TERRE DI PRENZANO, VIGNAMAGGIO, TUSCANY, 2020
The Vignamaggio family estate makes traditional, Tuscan wines at the very top level. The grapes for their 'Terre di Prenzano' are grown in the very best part of the higher quality Classico area. With dried herbs, spice and moreish sour cherry flavours, this wine is concentrated, yet restrained. | £45 |

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| 55 | BELEZOS RIOJA CRIANZA, BODEGAS ZUGOBER, 2020
Classic Rioja from small family winery. The palate displays rich plum, dark cherry fruit and warm spices, long lasting on the palate. <i>Also available by the glass</i> | £39 |
| 88 | PSI, PETER SISSECK, BODEGAS Y VINEDOS ALNARDO, RIBERA DEL DUERO, 2020
This is inviting, plum-purple in colour, with a firm, bright rim. The nose offers an explosion of ripe, aromatic, black fruit, plum and black cherry compote, complemented by mineral notes. The palate is expansive, generous with abundant fruit, richly textured and bursting with personality. Honest and accessible, this is energetic and lithe, driven and focused throughout, with a freshness and purity borne of natural acidity - harmonious and long on the finish - another winning Psi. | £67 |



AUSTRALIAN REDS

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| 49 | THE SOUTHERLY SHIRAZ, SOUTH-EAST AUSTRALIA, 2021
Deep garnet with purple hues the nose has vibrant red and black berries, with violets and sweet spice. The palate is silky with juicy black plums, sweet blueberry and a touch of mocha. | £37 |
| 50 | LITTLE TACKER GRENACHE SHIRAZ MOURVEDRE, BAROSSA VALLEY, 2018
Aromas of fresh raspberries, lavender and milk chocolate. The palate is generous and textured with ripe fruits of the forest, earthy notes and dark chocolate, toasty vanilla and a savoury finish. | £52 |

SOUTH AFRICA REDS

The following wines all come from the small estate owned by the much loved and admired golfing great that is Ernie Els. Founded in 1999 in the beautiful wine country of Stellenbosch in his native South Africa, while Ernie was in his pomp, he immediately employed the multi award winning winemaker Louis Strydom to look after his winery. This is very much a labour of love for both men, with very low production and the utmost quality being the watchwords here; so much so that they have achieved a rare 5 star rating by the South African wine guru John Platter in his guide.

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| 97 | THE MAJOR SERIES CABERNET SAUVIGNON, ERNIE ELS ESTATE, 2018
The 2017 is a lovely vintage showing the red fruit spectrum of Cabernet Sauvignon. The nose tempts with notes of coconut, vanilla, raspberries and sweet spice. This leads to a polished, supple palate opening to hints of fine white chocolate. The richness of cranberries and morello cherry gives length while the salty liquorice edge offers freshness and elegance. Crunchy, red-fruited tannins melt into a soft, slightly creamy finish | £61 |
| 98 | THE MAJOR SERIES MERLOT, ERNIE ELS ESTATE, 2017
The 2017 vintage Major Series Merlot has all the hallmarks of a classic Merlot, with ripe plums and earthy notes, supported by a core of minerality. The wine is fleshed out with ripe strawberry, forest underfloor and a hint of dark chocolate. This is a really lovely wine with a ripe juicy concentrated heart and a long finish. | £61 |
| 99 | PROPRIETOR'S BLEND, ERNIE ELS ESTATE, STELLENBOSCH, 2017
The Proprietors Blend (60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Shiraz, 5% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, 5% Malbec, and 5% Petit Verdot) is a towering Bordeaux style with a dash of Shiraz. It has a pitch-black core with a deeply rich hue, leading to a nose that dazzles with vanilla, blackberry, liquorice and cherry. Whiffs of wildflowers and a touch of cedar spice add refined depth and complexity, all coated by incredibly fine, chalky tannins. Slightly backward and brooding in its youth, there is an aristocratic feel to its long, silky and powerful finish | £71 |

NEW ZEALAND REDS

- 44 PINOT NOIR, ERADUS ESTATE, AWATARE VALLEY, MARLBOROUGH, 2022 £51
- Deep, dark ruby, with purple flashes. The nose has meaty, dark fruit and some farmyard notes. The palate has plenty of dark berry fruit and some savoury and earthy characters. This is all balanced with the trademark Eradus acidity, delicacy and freshness. *Also available by the glass*

CHILEAN REDS

- 41 BAINSKLOOF MERLOT, BREEDE RIVER, 2022 £35
- Deep ruby red in colour with rich mocha and sweet black fruit on the nose. The palate is reflective of the nose with additional ripe red fruit and leafy notes. *Also available by the glass*
- 52 PUERTAS ANTIGUAS SHIRAZ, VALLE CENTRAL, CHILE, 2022 £29
- This is a deliciously inviting wine – ripe, soft - textured and rich Shiraz, which bursts with black fruits, violet notes and a hint of peppery spice. *Also available by the glass*
- 53 CASA FELIPE CARMENÈRE, VALLE CENTRAL, 2022 £32
- Aromas of cherries and plums and subtle notes of mocha, chocolate and spices. Pleasing weight in the mouth, with sweet tannins and a velvety finish.

ARGENTINIAN REDS

- 46 CHAMUYO MALBEC, MENDOZA, 2020 £31
- A great introduction to Argentina's signature wine, made from mature vines in the cool Andean Foothills. This malbec is a juicy, supple wine with ripe summer fruits, herbs and warm spice. *Also available by the glass*
- 87 MALBEC, BODEGA RUCA MALEN, MENDOZA, 2022 £44
- A premium example of Argentina's signature Malbec grape, from boutique winery in Argentina's most classic wine producing region. The Upper Mendoza Valley has gained worldwide fame for its stunning, full-bodied reds. This Malbec vines grow at high altitudes, thus helping to combine power with elegance. With vibrant, cherry-plum notes and a spicy, liquorice finish, this wine is moreish and delicious.
